The Dental Hygiene Access for Certified Dental Assistants Program (DHAC) is a unique program specifically designed for CDAs as an alternative way of earning a dental hygiene diploma.

CDAs receive recognition for prior learning and complete the DHAC program through a combination of web-based theoretical and on-site clinical courses. Courses are scheduled over two years, so students can continue working part-time. Upon successful completion of the DHAC courses, students complete the final year of the Dental Hygiene Diploma Program at the downtown campus in Vancouver on a full-time basis.

All first-year university transfer (UT) courses required by dental hygiene programs in BC are available at VCC. UT courses begin January, May and September.
