What are the topics? The Coordinator is still in the planning stages and is hoping to choose topics that are relevant to your dental hygiene practice. Some topics might include current Issues and updates in Dental Hygiene, Dental Hygiene Care Plan for patients with dementia and patients with challenges with home care, implant care, psychopharmacology and medications used to treat mental health disorders, and issues related to opioid crisis.

The plan is to secure a presenter for each of the study club sessions with an opportunity for discussion with the rest of the study club members and the presenter. If you are interested in joining the study club the club Coordinator is interested in hearing from you as to topics that are of interest.

How do I access the sessions? The club will meet via a web-based platform called *GoToMeeting*. You will be able to access with your smart phone, tablet or computer (if you use a smart device you will need a pair of ear buds with a microphone or if you use a computer you will need a head set with a microphone and a USB connection)

What is the cost? \$50 to access all 4 sessions (8 hours of continuing education credits)
